

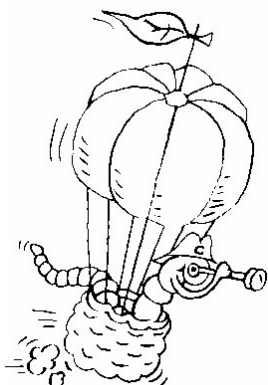

By participating in this event, your child should become more aware of why waste is an environmental problem and what they can do to reduce it.



After eating periods on the day, students will look at the quantity of waste produced and the types of items. Please help your child to participate in bring a low waste lunch and to feel able to reduce their impact on the environment for this day, and hopefully in the future also. The results of this Low-Waste Lunch Activity will be used in on-going schools education through Resource NSW Hunter Office Schools Program.
